**Volunteer Opportunities** 

Mini Golf: This requires 2 volunteers at one time on rotating shifts making

sure the kids are playing nicely and supervising the use of the

course, the golf balls and golf sticks.

Milk the Pretend Cow: This will require 2 volunteers at one time on rotating shifts to fill

up the rubber gloves and keep the area clean.

**Feed The Pretend Pigs:** This will require 2 volunteers at one time on rotating shifts to

keep the lines moving and help the kids with the bean bags and

make sure they use the equipment correctly.

**Biscuit Decorating:** This will require 2 volunteers at one time on rotating shifts to help

the kids decorate the biscuits and keep the area clean.

Giant Sand Pit: This requires 1 volunteer to keep an eye on the toys and supervise

the children in the pit.

**Dig for Vegetables:** This will require 2 volunteers to help the kids dig for the

vegetables and keep the area clean and re-bury the vegetables

once the kids have found them.

Volunteers are welcome to rotate their shifts with each other and also have breaks so they can go enjoy some time at the show.
